Following information from Herts Police regarding a Penge address, that an outstanding suspect who was wanted for a robbery which occurred in May 2022, officers from Penge & Cator, Crystal Palace & Upper Norwood, together with Clockhouse ward responded quickly, resulting in the female suspect being located and arrested.

An officer from Emergency Response Team C completed an investigation which resulted in a male receiving a sentence of 20 weeks in prison and a further 8 years of disqualified driving after being arrested for multiple driving offences following a pursuit in Bromley.

**Six people have been charged with the murder of Michael Jonas who died after being attacked and stabbed in Penge in 2017.**

[A] Ryan Brown, 20 of Croydon appeared in custody at Bromley Magistrates' Court on Wednesday, 12 October charged with murder. He has been remanded in custody to next appear at the Old Bailey on Monday, 17 October.

[B] Jamie Marshall, 21 of SE20 appeared in custody at Exeter Magistrates' Court on Thursday, 13 October charged with murder. He has been remanded in custody to next appear at Truro Crown Court on Monday, 17 October.

[C] Divon Henry-Campbell – 22 of Gravesend appeared in custody at Bromley Magistrates' Court on Friday, 14 October charged with murder. He has been remanded in custody to next appear at the Old Bailey on Monday, 17 October.

[D] Sorraviho Smith – 22

[E] Jason Smith – 19

[F] Nyron Jean-Baptiste – 21 have all been charged by postal requisition with murder to appear at Bromley Magistrates' Court on Tuesday, 18 October.

Michael, aged 17, died after being attacked and stabbed in Betts Park, Penge on 2 November 2017.

The charges follow an investigation by homicide detectives from the Met's Specialist Crime Command.

Officers from Response Team D attended a call to reports of a robbery in West Wickham, where four suspects matching the description were stopped in the area, one of whom had a knife.

Three suspects were arrested for Robbery and another for robbery and possession of an offensive weapon.

## Two people have been convicted in connection with the fatal stabbing of Camron Smith in Croydon

The two men were convicted on Wednesday, 26 October following a trial at the Old Bailey. They will be sentenced on Friday, 2 December. Read the full article [click here](#)

### **Detective Sergeant Mike Seager, of the Met's Specialist Crime Command,**

**said:** "Camron was from Shrublands in Croydon and was just 16 years old when his life was so brutally ended in a frenzy of violence in his own home. I attended the scene and saw the injuries inflicted on Camron and they were truly dreadful. The entire investigation team knew they were dealing with vicious criminals and they were determined to bring those responsible to justice.

"Despite the complexity of the investigation, and attempts to hinder our enquiries, we have succeeded in bringing most of those involved to justice, but let me make it clear, we will not stop until we have brought to trial all those we suspect to be involved.

"As for these defendants, despite their ages, they are dangerous violent individuals who cannot be permitted to move freely within the community. I am pleased with the jury's verdicts – I hope that Camron's loved ones find some comfort in this outcome."

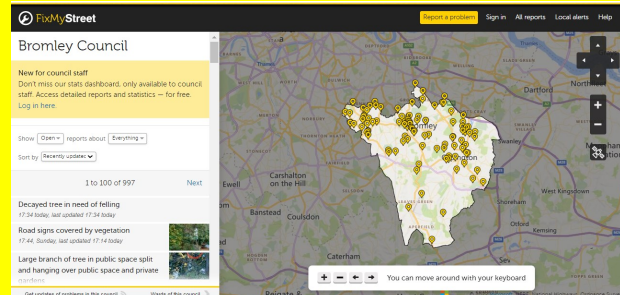




Mottingham Impact Day. Dedicated Ward Officers from Mottingham, along with other agencies
